Visa

Visa Application Requirements:

- Application Form: Complete the Visa Application Form.
- Passport: Must be valid for 6 months beyond entry date.
- Visa Fee: Submit proof of visa application fee payment.
- Photo: Provide a recent passport-sized photo.
- Supporting Documents: Include invitation letters or schedules confirming the purpose of visit.

Visa On Arrival (VoA):

- Pre-approval: Obtain a pre-approval letter for VoA at least 8 business days before arriving in Vietnam through a travel agency or Vietnamese sponsor.
- Arrival Procedure: Present the pre-approval letter, passport, entry/exit form, and two photos at VoA counters in Vietnam's international airports.
- Stamping Fee: Pay the fee upon arrival.



Visa

Expedited Entry:

- Availability: For trade delegations, expedited entry may include dedicated counters or assistance from local sponsors.
- Arrangement: Coordinate with Vietnamese authorities or the Chamber of Commerce in advance for smoother immigration clearance.

Key Points:

Verify Information: Check the latest visa policies with the Vietnamese embassy before travel. Visa Exemption: Some countries have visa exemption agreements with Vietnam. Health Regulations: Ensure compliance with any required health measures. For up-to-date information, visit the Vietnam Immigration Department's website or contact the nearest Vietnamese embassy.

This streamlined guide offers a quick overview of the essential steps and requirements for obtaining a visa and ensuring smooth entry into Vietnam for trade mission participants.

Health Requirements

Before traveling to Vietnam, check the latest health requirements:

Vaccinations: Mandatory for certain countries, especially for Yellow Fever. Recommended vaccinations include Hepatitis A and B, Typhoid, and Tetanus.

COVID-19: Regulations may include vaccination proof, negative tests, and health declarations, subject to change.

Health Declaration: Often required upon arrival.

For current information, consult the Vietnam Ministry of Health, the nearest Vietnamese embassy, or official travel advisories. Always verify requirements close to your travel date to ensure compliance.



Getting to know Ho Chi Minh City

Basic Information

- Population: 9,320,866
- GDP per capita: \$7,000 (nearly twice of the national average of most cities in Vietnam)



Ho Chi Minh City is the largest city in Vietnam and a pivotal economic, cultural, and educational hub. With an estimated population of over 9.32 million people sprawling across an area of 2,095 square kilometers, the city is a vibrant metropolis characterized by its dynamic urban landscape and significant rural outskirts.



Strategically situated in the southeastern part of Vietnam, Ho Chi Minh City serves as a crucial gateway connecting the Mekong Delta to the rest of the world through its extensive network of rivers, canals, and the Tan Cang Cat Lai – is one of the busiest ports in Asia. The city's geographical advantage has bolstered its status as a vital commercial and transport hub, fostering growth in various sectors including manufacturing, technology, and services.





The heart of Vietnam's economic boom, Ho Chi Minh City has seen rapid development in its infrastructure and business sectors since the country's economic reforms (Doi Moi) initiated in 1986. It hosts numerous international corporations, local conglomerates, and a thriving startup ecosystem. The city is also a major tourist destination, known for its historical sites, including remnants of the French colonial era, the War Remnants Museum, and the Cu Chi Tunnels, offering insights into Vietnam's tumultuous past.

Culturally, Ho Chi Minh City is a melting pot of traditions and modernity. District 1, the city's bustling central district, contrasts sharply with the more traditional and serene District 5's Chinatown, known as Cholon. Here, visitors can explore vibrant markets, ancient pagodas, and temples alongside skyscrapers and modern shopping malls.

The city's culinary scene is renowned worldwide, offering a plethora of dining experiences from street food stalls serving local delicacies like pho and banh mi to upscale restaurants offering international cuisine. The vibrant nightlife of Ho Chi Minh City, with its bars, nightclubs, and live music venues, reflects its youthful and energetic population.



Significant urban development projects, such as the Thu Thiem New Urban Area and the metro system, are underway to transform Ho Chi Minh City's infrastructure and urban landscape further. These developments aim to enhance the quality of life for residents and improve the city's sustainability and connectivity.

Environmental conservation efforts are also notable, with initiatives to protect the city's green spaces and waterways, amidst the challenges of rapid urbanization. The Can Gio Mangrove Forest, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve located just outside the city, exemplifies these efforts, offering a unique ecological site where visitors can explore rich biodiversity.

Ho Chi Minh City continues to stand as a symbol of Vietnam's resilience and ambition, driving the country's economic growth while preserving its cultural heritage and embracing modernity. Its dynamic atmosphere, rich history, and promising future make it an essential part of Vietnam's identity on the global stage.





Airport



Ho Chi Minh City is primarily served by Tan Son Nhat International Airport, the largest in Vietnam, located about 6 kilometers north of the city center. It offers both international (Terminal 2) and domestic (Terminal 1) flights, connecting the city globally. The airport provides easy access to the city via taxis, ridehailing services, and public buses, with a metro link planned to enhance connectivity. Despite its capacity, the upcoming Long Thanh International Airport will eventually take over most international traffic to alleviate congestion. Tan Son Nhat remains vital for the city's connectivity and development.

Weather in March

Ho Chi Minh City experiences a tropical climate with March marking the transition towards the hot and dry season. The average temperature in March is about 30 (86F) degrees Celsius, with peak temperatures often reaching up to 34(93F) degrees Celsius, while the nighttime lows average around 24 (75F) degrees Celsius.

The humidity levels remain high, averaging around 70%. Rainfall begins to decrease this month, with an average precipitation of about 40 mm 1.6 inches). As the weather transitions, occasional late-afternoon showers can occur, gradually giving way to drier conditions as the month progresses.

To stay comfortable in Ho Chi Minh City's March weather, it's advisable to wear light, breathable clothing and stay hydrated. Also, consider carrying an umbrella or raincoat for unexpected showers.



Dress Code

Considering Ho Chi Minh City's tropical climate, we recommend that delegates opt for light, breathable clothing suitable for the warm and humid conditions typical of the area. Vietnamese dress code is generally casual, reflecting the city's laid-back atmosphere. For business meetings and formal events within the MBDA trade delegation, smart casual attire is appropriate, with no necessity for a tie unless specified for particular occasions. Comfortable footwear is also advised due to the likelihood of walking in warm conditions.

Accommodation

For the MBDA trade delegation trip to Ho Chi Minh City, it's important to note that as part of the arrangements, the organization will cover the accommodation costs for all delegates at the Sheraton Saigon Hotel & Towers from the 18th to the 23rd. Phone calls

Cell phone coverage in Ho Chi Minh City is comprehensive, with robust networks ensuring connectivity across the city, including business districts, residential areas, and most tourist destinations. However, it's worth noting that in certain locations, particularly on the outskirts or in less urbanized areas, signal strength may vary, potentially affecting call quality and data services.

Visitors have the option to use their mobile phones via international roaming, though it's often more economical to purchase a local prepaid SIM card. 4G LTE networks may also be available depending on the local coverage and your U.S. carrier. These SIM cards are affordable, widely available at airports, convenience stores, and mobile phone shops, and can be activated quickly with just your passport for identification. Vietnam's country code is +84.

Wi-Fi access is reliably available in Ho Chi Minh City, particularly in hotels, cafes, restaurants, and public spaces, ensuring that delegates will have internet access throughout their stay. This makes staying connected, conducting business, or keeping in touch with international contacts convenient during your visit.

Electricity

The electrical power supply in Ho Chi Minh City operates at 220 volts with Type A and Type C electrical sockets. Type A sockets are two-prong plugs, commonly used in North America, while Type C sockets are two-prong plugs used in Europe, with the pins being round.

For devices that require a nominal current of up to 16 amperes, Type C plugs are standard, accommodating the majority of personal electronics such as mobile devices, laptops, and cameras.

Delegates are advised to bring suitable adapters for their electronic devices to ensure compatibility with the Vietnamese electrical system. It's also recommended to check the voltage requirements for your devices, as some may need a converter to adjust from 220 volts to the device's required voltage.





Currency and Available Banks

The currency used in Vietnam is the Vietnamese Dong (VND). While electronic payments with debit and credit cards are increasingly accepted, especially in urban areas like Ho Chi Minh City, it is advisable to carry some cash for smaller transactions. ATMs are readily available throughout the city, providing convenient access to cash withdrawals.

Visa and Mastercard are the most widely accepted credit cards in Ho Chi Minh City. American Express (AMEX) may be accepted at high-end hotels, restaurants, and shopping centers, but its acceptance is less common compared to Visa and Mastercard. For ease of transactions and to avoid any potential inconvenience, it is recommended to have a Visa or Mastercard on hand during your stay in Vietnam.

Security

Ho Chi Minh City is generally considered safe for visitors compared to other major cities in the region, but it's still important to exercise common sense and take necessary precautions to ensure your safety, especially in a bustling metropolis.

Here are some tips to keep in mind during your visit:

Avoid carrying large sums of cash.

Be discreet with jewelry and other valuables to avoid attracting attention.

Always keep an eye on your personal belongings, such as laptops, smartphones, bags, and backpacks.

Emergency Numbers in Vietnam Should you encounter any emergencies, the following numbers can be dialed: Fire Department: 114 Police: 113 Ambulance/Medical Emergencies: 115 Civil Defense: Dial the local number specific to the area within Vietnam for non-medical emergencies.

It's a good idea to have these numbers saved or written down somewhere accessible during your stay in Ho Chi Minh City. Staying aware of your surroundings and following these precautions will help you enjoy a safe and pleasant visit.
